

POROUS VS NON-POROUS

POROUS

- Typically softer toys
- Traps dirt & bacteria that can cause an infection
- Difficult/impossible to completely clean
- Cannot be fully sanitized
- Always use with a condom
- Materials include: PVC, TPE/TPR, Jelly, Real-Feel or Cyberskin

NON-POROUS

- Made of materials that won't trap bacteria
- Can be sterilized and disinfected
- Doesn't require condom if clean
- Materials include: Metal, Glass, ABS Hard Plastic, Wood, Pure Silicone, Stone

When possible, always buy **non-porous** toys from reputable sources.
If you use a porous toy, use a condom every time.
